

Housing Allowance Expenses Checklist

1. Principle payments on your home, mortgage interest, rent, down payments, rental deposits, property tax, renters insurance, real estate fees and home insurance.
2. Improvements to the home and/or contents including repairs, upkeep, new carpeting, roof, kitchen refurbishing, room addition, fence...)
3. Furniture and appliances including washers, dryers, vacuum cleaners, toasters, microwaves, carpet cleaners, lawn mowers, computers, printers, dish washers, TV's, VCR's, DVD players, entertainment centers, pianos, telephones, cell phones, beds, couches, chairs, tables...
4. Items used in home including dishes, silverware, towels, bedding, window dressings, rugs, sewing machines, door openers...
5. Utilities including gas, electric, water, sewer, trash, telephone, cable TV, satellite TV, internet ...
6. Miscellaneous including paint, pictures, flowers, dish soap, towels used for dishes, tools for repairing the house, light bulbs, cleaning supplies, brooms, and any thing else to maintain the home...
